Our Philosophy



- Mentoring is a WORK both for mentors and mentees
- Both invest **time** and **effort** to reach the goal defined together
- Focusing on a **professional topic**
- NOT a friendship,
- NOT a psychological session



Challenges and Learnings



- Enthusiasm is not equal knowledge
 - The mentor should be an expert of her field
- Avalilability of the mentor
 - "Just a quick question…" the answer takes hours
- Open-end mentoring
 - Concentrated work gets lost due to extended time frame
- Volunteering no costs, no risks
 - No pressure to take the work/goals seriously, drop-out
- Defined topics
 - E.g. "First steps in Vienna" too wide
- Matching the profiles
 - Chemistry between mentors and mentees

Mentoring Program as a Service -"WORK, WORK, WORK!"

- Defining Quality
 Standards
 - Selected Pool of Experts
 - Application process for mentees
 - Appointing a Senior
 Mentor
 - Mid-/Final Evaluation





Formalization and Communication

• **Communication** of the program

- Visibility on social media (closed fb-group, blog, videos)
- Closing ceremony with certificate
- Legal issues
 - Contract between mentors/mentees and Femspace
 - Agreement between mentors and mentees about the goals and work
 - How to quit the program
 - GDPR, privacy issues, scientology





Structure and Monetarization



- Mentoring is a WORK
- Defined time frame:
 - 6 meetings
 - within 4 months,
 - 1,5-2 hours per session
- Costs: 500 €
 - Professional investment of a person





Successes and Future Plans



- Seriousness of the program increased
- Group of mentors boiled down to a pool of experts
- Less participants but higher quality
- Requests for Recommendation Letters for job applications
- Mentoring in German and English
